

## **Emergency department activity** Information for users



Due to a shortage of emergency doctors, from March 1, 2024 until June 30, access to the Lannion hospital emergency department will be regulated by the SAMU, every night from 7pm to 8:30am.

What does regulated access to emergency departments at night mean?

The Lannion emergency service and the Mobile Emergency and Resuscitation Service (SMUR) operates 24 hours a day:

Daytime, 8.30am to 7pm

the usual access procedures remain unchanged

Overnight, from 7pm to 8.30am the following morning

you are asked to call 15 instead of going directly to the emergency department



You will then receive the most appropriate advice or guidance for your state of health by telephone.

The Maternity Ward and gynaecological emergencies will continue to be open 24 hours a day.

We are doing our utmost to recruit practitioners and get back to business as usual as quickly as possible.
